How to Clean Your Roof*

- 1. Use a dry brush to remove moss or lichen.
- 2. Remove remaining debris.
- 3. Clean the gutters and ensure water flows freely.
- 4. Protect nearby plants from chemical burns.
- 5. Apply a roofing cleaner, following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 6. Always use low pressure, soft bristles, and a light touch. Avoid dislodging granules on asphalt shingles.

*A healthy roof shouldn't need cleaning every year. If you have repeat algae or moss growth, have your roof inspected by a professional.

Safety Measures For Roof Work

- Always have a spotter nearby.
- Only climb on a roof if you feel safe.
- Always wear a safety harness and use a ladder stabilizer.
- Wear shoes with non-slip soles.
